1st Mention in Genesis (2:3): T:me

So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation.

1st Mention in Exodus (3:5): Place

Then He said, "Do not come near; take your sandals off your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground."

1st Mention in Leviticus (2:3): $\mathcal{T}_{1, \eta, g, s}$

1st Mention in Numbers (3:13): People
