After reading about the sin-offering –

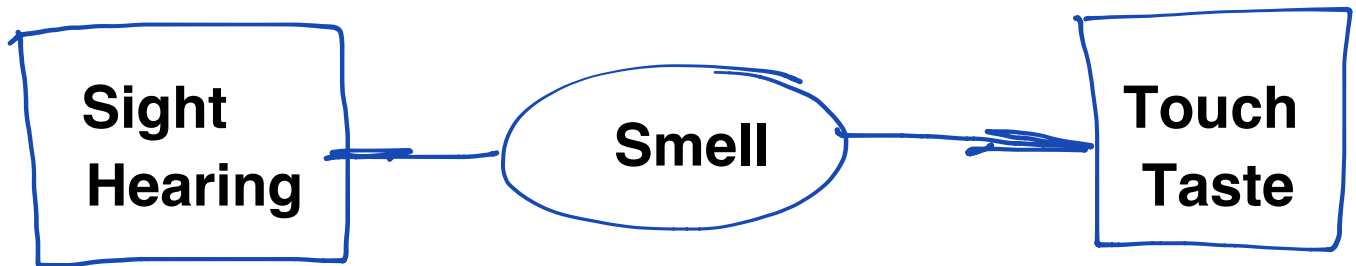
