## **Q: Did Yeshua ever become unclean?**

#### Exodus 29:37

Seven days you shall make atonement for the <u>altar</u> and consecrate it, and the altar shall be <u>most holy</u>. Whatever touches the altar shall become holy.

You shall consecrate them, that they may be most holy. Whatever touches them will become holy.

## Hebrews 10:19-22

Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Yeshua, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

## Nehemiah 9:17

They refused to obey and were not mindful of the wonders that You performed among them, but they stiffened their neck and appointed a leader to return to their slavery in Egypt. But You are a God ready to forgive, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, and did not forsake them.

## **Psalm 86:15**

But you, Adonai, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.





# **Q: But what IS grace?**

## A: Grace ≠ Unmerited Favor

# **GRACE = FAVOR**

## ...whether merited or not

## Genesis 6:8-9

But Noah found grace in the eyes of Adonai. These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God.

### Exodus 33:13

Now therefore, if I have found grace in Your sight, please show me now Your ways, that I may know You in order to find grace in Your sight...

## Psalm 84:11

For the LORD God is a sun and shield; Adonai bestows grace and honor. No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

## Proverbs 3:3-4

Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart. So you will find grace and good success in the sight of God and man.

## **Proverbs 3:34**

He indeed scorns the scorners; but He gives grace unto the humble.

## Luke 2:52

And Yeshua increased in wisdom and in stature and in grace with God and man.

## **Romans 3:24**

...and are justified by His grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Messiah Yeshua...

## **Romans 1:3-6**

...concerning his Son, Who was descended from David according to the flesh and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by His resurrection from the dead, Yeshua the Messiah our Lord, through Whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of His name among all the nations, including you who are called to belong to Messiah Yeshua...
