



### **1 Corinthians 3:12-15**

The soulish person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.



# The Experience of Soulish Believers

#### Soulish believers ...

- Are inordinately curious
- Tend to show off their differences and superiorities
- Like to argue and reason
- Assume an attitude of self-righteousness
- Are easily moved emotionally
- Are over-sensitive
- Are easily troubled by outside matters
- Are very proud

# The Works of Soulish Believers

- Soulish believers are second to none in the matter of works
- The labor of soulish believers chiefly depends upon feeling
- Soulish believers crave works but are unable to maintain calm in their spirit
- They are readily discouraged in their exertions
- They are experts at finding fault
- Soulish believers love to use spiritual phraseology
- A vaunting ambition marks out those who live in the realm of the soul
- Soulish believers usually possess magnetic personalities

# Q: How can a soulish believer become a spiritual believer?

A: He must deliver his soul over to death.

# The Affection of the Soul:

Matthew 10:38-39

# The Self of the Soul:

Matthew 16:24-25

Then Yeshua told His disciples, "If anyone would come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me. For whoever would save his soul will lose it, but whoever loses his soul for My sake will find it."
