

Yeshua's Teaching on Prayer: Points to Remember

"Our Father..."

- We are part of a community.
- Note to Whom you are praying.

John 14:6 Yeshua said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

"...Who is in Heaven..."

There is still an awkward distance between God and us...

"...May Your Name be kept holy."

...and there should be a distance between us and the world.

"May Your Kingdom come..."

Our time here is a time of patient endurance and preparation...

"...and may Your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven."

...as we live our lives according to His Torah.

Isaiah 56:6-7 "And the foreigners who join themselves to Adonai, to minister to Him, to love the name of Adonai, and to be His servants, everyone who keeps the Sabbath and does not profane it, and holds fast My covenant — these I will bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on My altar; for My house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples."

Psalm 103:17-19 But the steadfast love of Adonai is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear Him, and His righteousness to children's children, to those who keep His covenant and remember to do His commandments. Adonai has established His throne in the heavens, and His kingdom rules over all.

"Give us today our daily bread."

■ Like manna, we receive a daily supply of grace.

"And forgive us our wrongs to the degree we have forgiven those who wrong us."

 God's attitude toward us reflects our attitude toward others.

"And do not lead us into testing..."

Don't make the mistake that David made!

Psalm 26:1-2 "Judge me, Adonai, for I have walked in my integrity, and I have trusted in Adonai without wavering. Prove me, Adonai, and try me; test my heart and my mind."

"...but deliver us from evil."

But when we do fail a test, God uses that for our good.

Psalm 51 To the choirmaster. A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet went to him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba...

... (17) The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Job 5:17-19 "Behold, blessed is the one whom God reproves; therefore despise not the discipline of the Almighty. For He wounds, but He binds up; He shatters, but His hands heal. He will deliver you from six troubles; in seven no evil shall touch you.

"For Yours is the Kingdom, and the Power, and the Glory forever."

Daniel 7:27 And the kingdom and the dominion and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High; their kingdom shall be an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey them.

"Amen."
