

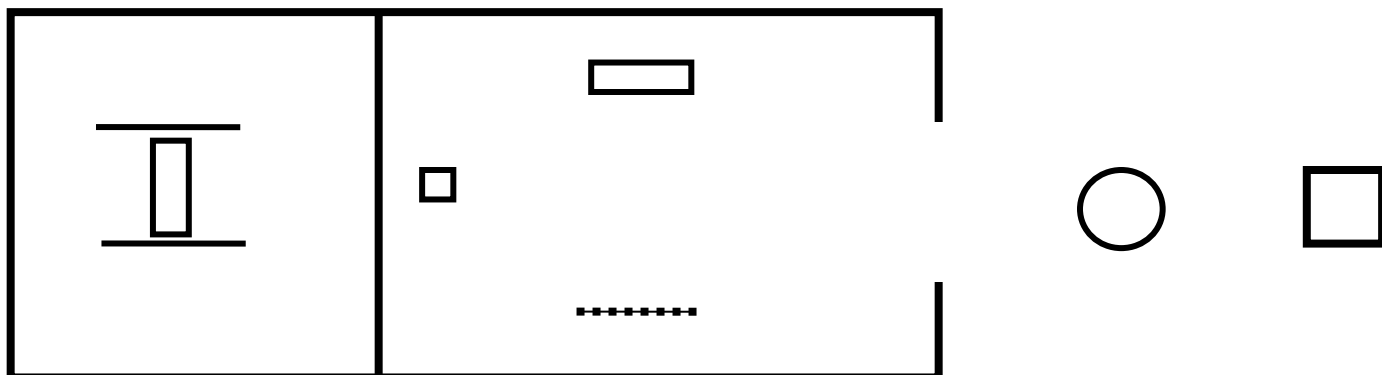
# *Prayer*
