

∞ Micah 5:2 ∞



∞ Matthew 2:23 ∞

***And he went and lived in a city called Nazareth, that what was spoken by the prophets might be fulfilled: “He shall be called a Nazarene.”***

∞ Isaiah 11:1 ∞

***There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit.***
