A SIX STEP COURSE IN RIGHTEOUSNESS:

Matthew 3:15

But Yeshua answered him, "Let it be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill ($\pi\lambda\eta\rho\omega\sigma\alpha\iota$) all righteousness." Then he consented.

Matthew 5:6

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Matthew 5:10

Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:20

For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

Responses to grace and forgiveness:
