
The Torah of Freedom

Pirkei Avot 6:2 – “...And it says [Exodus 32:16]: ‘The tablets are God’s handiwork and the script was God’s script engraved (charut) on the tablets.’ Do not read ‘charut’ (engraved) but ‘cherut’ (freedom), for you can have no freer man than one who engages in the study of the Torah....”

חָרוּת = “engraved”

חֵרוּת = “freedom”

Galatians 5:6 – “For in Messiah neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything, but **faith working through love.**”

Galatians 6:15 – “For neither is circumcision anything, nor uncircumcision, but **a new creation.**”

I Corinthians 7:19 – “Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but what matters is **the keeping of the commandments of God.**”
