

## A RECIPE FOR REBELLION

- ❁ **Korah** (קֹרַח), **Dathan** (דָּתָן), and **Abiram** (אַבִּירָם) illustrate three aspects of rebellion.
- ❁ The names of **Dathan** & **Abiram** are always mentioned together (10x) in Scripture.
- ❁ Though we may each have a bit of Korah in us, we are more prone to be like Dathan and Abiram.
