- “A king for them” (8:22)
- From Benjamin (9:1)
- Exceptionally handsome, tall (9:2)
- Pursues donkeys (9:3)  
...but fails
- Visits Samuel (9:10)
- Has no bread (9:7)
- Oil from a “flask” (10:1)
- Spirit “passes over” (10:10-13)
- Hides among baggage (10:22)
- 1<sup>st</sup> battle - Amorites
- Corronated in Gilgal (11:14-15)

## David

- “A king for Myself” (16:1)
- From Judah
- Pleasing, ruddy, fair eyes (16:12)
- Shepherds sheep (16:11)  
...succeeds (17:34-36)
- Visited by Samuel (16:1)
- “House of Bread” (16:4)
- Oil from a “horn” (16:13)
- Spirit remains (16:13)
- Leaves the baggage (17:22)
- 1<sup>st</sup> battle – Goliath
- Corronated in Hebron (II Sam. 5:1-3)
