- **Ignorance** – *“Who is David and who is the son of Jesse?”*
 - **Prejudice** – *“These days the rebellious servants have increased, each against his master!”*
 - **Selfishness** – *“Should I take from **my** bread and **my** water and **my** meat that I have slaughtered for **my** shearers and I give them to men about whose origin I do not know?”*

- **Self Indulgence** – “He was having a feast in his house – a feast fit for a king.”
 - **Pride** – “Nabal’s heart was pleased about himself.”
 - **Lack of Self Control** – “He was very drunk”
 - **Ignorance of the Unseen** – “She did not tell him anything minor or major until the morning’s light.”
 - **Dead and Stony Heart** – “His heart died within him and it was like a stone.”
