- *kodesh* – “holiness”
- *kadosh* – “holy”
- *k'dushah* – “section of prayer service”
- *kaddish* – “memorial prayer”
- *kiddush* – “blessing of Shabbat”
- *kiddushin* – “wedding ceremony”

2 Corinthians 12:2

Exodus 20:18

Now when all the people saw the thunder and the flashes of lightning and the sound of the trumpet and the mountain smoking, the people were afraid and trembled, and they stood far off.

Leviticus 16:12

He is to take a censer full of burning coals from the altar before ADONAI and, with his hands full of ground, fragrant incense, bring it inside the curtain.

Exodus 30:7-8

Aaron will burn fragrant incense on it as a pleasing aroma every morning; he is to burn it when he prepares the lamps. Aaron is also to burn it when he lights the lamps at dusk; this is the regular burning of incense before ADONAI through all your generations.
