R' Isaac said that the words 'For with You is the fountain of life..' [Psalm 36:9] refer to the High Priest above Who corresponds to the high priest below.

Power and effect are vested in the Priest, inasmuch as the power of the body is chiefly displayed in the right arm. The Priest was therefore the right arm of all Israel, charged to set right Israel and all the world. Nevertheless he, together with the left side, was part of the body, the body being the all-in-all.

Why is vayisem spelled with two yuds? It shows the connection between one covenant and another covenant, one in the secret of the lower, and the other in the secret of the upper. 'Then he was placed in an aron.' Why so? Because he observed the holy covenant, which was established through him. Therefore he deserved to be put in an aron and everything is proper.


Two important terms...
