#1- Block Logic

Embracing true statements which may not easily harmonize with others.

Tolerance of contradiction & paradox.

SYMPTOMS OF OVEREMPHASIS ON FREE WILL

- Increasing Exhaustion
- Nagging Fears
- Nagging Doubts
- Emphasis on Gifts of the Spirit (vs. Fruit of the Spirit)
- Conformity of Behavior
- Emphasis on Justice more than Mercy
- Emotion Extremes signify Maturity
- Prayers implore instant deliverance
- Weaknesses & Struggles must be kept Hidden
- "Letter of the Law" trumps "Spirit of the Law"
- Demand for Perfect Obedience
- Leaders seek Control
- Fear of Wrong Choices leads to preference for:
 - \circ Signs
 - Strongly enforced prohibitions
 - \circ Relinquishing choice to others

SYMPTOMS OF OVEREMPHASIS ON GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY

- The "Redeemed" life little different from a "Good" one
- Ritual more important than Spirituality
- Emphasis on God's Mercy more than God's Justice
- God's Plans are for Him to fulfill
- Teaching focuses on comfort and assurance, not conviction and change
- Tolerance for long-term sin
- Emphasis on Remorse rather than Repentance
- God's Promises are always unconditional
- "Christian" label broadly applied
- Fight against Evil is a societal rather than a personal battle
- Self-Examination discouraged
- Fear of being labeled "Judgmental" prevents correction

Believing is Seeing vs Seeing is Believing


Matthew 11:25-26
