

The Kinsman Redeemer



- Must be a kinsman and have financial resources
- Restores one who falls into poverty and/or slavery
- Avenges the wrongful death of a relative

Leviticus 25:25

If a fellow countryman of yours becomes so poor he has to sell part of his property, then his **redeemer** is to come and **redeem** what his relative has sold.

Ruth 2:20

Naomi said to her daughter-in-law, "May he be blessed of ADONAI who has not withdrawn his kindness to the living and to the dead." Again Naomi said to her, "The man is our relative, he is our redeemer."

Hebrews 2:14-15
