#### **Exodus 26:18**

"You shall make the boards for the tabernacle: **twenty** boards for the south side."

#### Exodus 26:20

"...and for the second side of the tabernacle, on the north side, **twenty** boards."

#### Exodus 26:22

*"For the rear of the tabernacle, to the west, you shall make six boards."* 

SOUTH side	= 20 boards
NORTH side	= 20 boards
WEST side	= 6 boards
TOTAL	= <u>46</u>

# Exodus 26:1


*"Moreover you shall make the tabernacle with ten curtains of fine twisted linen and blue and purple and scarlet material..."* 

# Exodus 26:7

"Then you shall make curtains of goats' hair for a tent over the tabernacle; you shall make **eleven curtains** in all."

#### Exodus 26:14

"You shall make **a covering** for the tent of rams' skins dyed red and **a covering** of tachash skins above."



Where did they have planks from? Our forefather Yaakov planted them when he went down to Egypt. He said to his sons, "My sons, in the future you will be redeemed from here, and the Holy One, Blessed Is He, will tell you once you are redeemed, that you should make for him a Sanctuary [Mishkan], so prepare and plant cedars now, so that when the time comes and he tells you to make the Mishkan, the cedars will be ready for you."

## Summary

- Jacob's descendants: 46 from Leah & Rachel, 23 from their handmaidens
- The Tabernacle: 46 structural planks, 23 tapestries as coverings
- The human cell: 46 chromosomes in regular cells, 23 in reproductive cells



# Exodus 1:1-7

Now these are the names of the sons of Israel who came to Egypt with Jacob; they came each one with his household: Reuben, Simeon, Levi and Judah; Issachar, Zebulun and Benjamin; Dan and Naphtali, Gad and Asher. All the persons who came from the loins of Jacob were seventy in number, but Joseph was already in Egypt. Joseph died, and all his brothers and all that generation. But the sons of Israel were fruitful and increased greatly, and multiplied, and became exceedingly mighty, so that the land was filled with them.




