- We must leave our “father's house” to arrive at our “Father's House”.

“... To the land which I will show you ...”

- We must put our trust in the One who leads us, not in our imaginations.
- Our confidence is in our Shepherd, not in the landscape.

Built a city... (11:4)

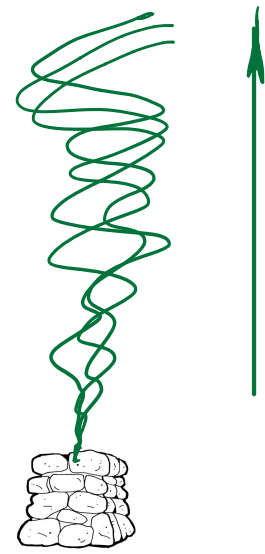
Sought a city (Hebrews 11:10)
