## Genesis 2c

### Genesis 2:1

*Thus the heavens and the earth were completed (וַיִּכְלֹוּ, *vay'culu*), and all their hosts.*

### Psalm 84:2

*“My soul longed and even yearned for the courts of Adonai...”*

## Genesis 2:2


And by the seventh day Elohim completed His work which He had done; **and He desisted** (וַיִּשְׁבַּת, va'yishbat) on the seventh day from all His work which He had done.

## Genesis 2:3

Then Elohim blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He desisted from all His work which Elohim **had created** (בָּרָא, bara) **to make** (לַעֲשׂוֹת, la'asot).

## Genesis 2:4

This is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that Adonai Elohim made earth and heaven.

"very" = וְרַב      אָדָם = "Adam"  


## Genesis 2:8

And Adonai Elohim planted a garden **to the east** (מִקְדָּם, *mi'kedem*), in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed.

## Psalms 68:33

To Him who rides upon the highest heavens, which are from **ancient times** (*kedem*); behold, He speaks forth with His voice, a mighty voice.

## Genesis 2:10-14

Now a river went out of Eden to water the garden, and from there it divided and becomes four heads. The name of the one is Pishon (פִּישׁוֹן), the one encircling the whole land of Chavilah, where the gold is. And the gold of that land is good; there is the bedolach and the shoham stone. And the name of the second river is Gichon (גִּיחוֹן), which is the one encircling the whole land of Cush. And the name of the third river Chidekel (חִדְקֵל), which is the one that flows eastward to Ashur [Assyria]. And the fourth river is Pherat (פֶּרַת) [Euphrates].

## Genesis 2:16-17

And Adonai Elohim **commanded** (וַיִּצַו, va'yatzav) the adam, saying, "From every **tree** (עֵץ, eitz) of the garden you may eat freely, but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it **dying you shall die** ( מות תמות, mot tamut) ."

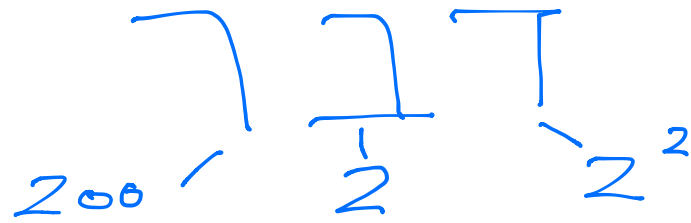

## Genesis 2:19-20

*And out of the ground Adonai Elohim formed every beast of the field and every bird of the heavens, and brought [them] to the adam to see what **he would call** (יִקְרָא, yikra) each one, and whatever the adam called a living creature, that was its name. And the adam gave names to all the cattle, and to the birds of the sky, and to every beast of the field, but for Adam there was not found a helper opposite him.*
