The *arum* (ערום, *arum*) sees the evil and hides himself, but the naive go on, and are punished for it.


Satan is not interested in getting you to do what HE wants. He is interested in getting you to do what YOU want.


Luke 22:42

"Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from Me. Nevertheless, not My will, but Yours, be done."




Proverbs 12:15
