Genesis 3:9

*Then Adonai Elohim called to the adam, and said to him, “**Where are you** (אֵיכָה, eichah)?”*

Lamentations 1:1

***How** (אֵיכָה, eichah) lonely sits the city that was once full of people! She has become like a widow ...*

Question 1: *Who told you that you were naked?*

Question 2: *Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?*

The “Mirror Effect”

- Those who *do not* “see” God clearly, do not see themselves clearly.
- Those who *do* “see” God clearly, see themselves clearly.
 - – See own flaws and shortcomings
 - + See selves through God’s eyes of love.
- When we look in a mirror we see two images:
 - The image that is reflected
 - The image in our minds
- When we look into the mirror of the Word, we see two images:
 - A reflection of ourselves (James 1:23-24)
 - An image of God (1 Cor. 13:12/2 Cor. 3:18)
