

Exodus 32:9-14,31

Adonai said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and behold, they are an obstinate people. Now then let Me alone, that My anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them; and I will make of you a great nation." Then Moses entreated Adonai his God, and said, "O Adonai, why does Your anger burn against Your people whom You have brought out from the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand? Why should the Egyptians speak, saying, 'With evil *intent* He brought them out to kill them in the mountains and to destroy them from the face of the earth'? Turn from Your burning anger and change Your mind about *doing* harm to Your people. Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, Your servants to whom You swore by Yourself, and said to them, 'I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heavens, and all this land of which I have spoken I will give to your descendants, and they shall inherit *it* forever.'" So Adonai changed His mind about the harm which He said He would do to His people.

Then Moses returned to Adonai, and said, "Alas, this people has committed a great sin, and they have made a god of gold for themselves. But now, if You will, forgive their sin – and if not, please blot me out from Your book which You have written!"

In the same way that Judah was willing to offer himself in Benjamin's place, Moses was willing to offer himself for the sake of his brothers.

Exodus 33:3,15-17

"Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; for I will not go up in your midst, because you are an obstinate people, and I might destroy you on the way."

Then he said to Him, "If Your presence does not go *with us*, do not lead us up from here. For how then can it be known that I have found favor in Your sight, I and Your people? Is it not by Your going with us, so that we, I and Your people, may be distinguished from all the *other* people who are upon the face of the earth?" Adonai said to Moses, "I will also do this thing of which you have spoken; for you have found favor in My sight and I have known you by name."

In the same way that Moses expressed his unwillingness to accompany God to Egypt but to send someone else instead, God expresses His unwillingness to accompany Moses and Israel to Canaan and that He will send someone else instead.

Exodus 33:18

Then Moses said, "I pray You, show me Your glory!"

In the same way that Joseph revealed his identity to his brothers after Judah passed his test, God revealed Himself to Moses after Moses passed his test.

Cattle: Two Views

The Jewish view:

- A- For use by man for labor and for food
- B- For use in service to God

The Egyptian view:

A- As objects of worship (as gods)

When Pharaoh made Joseph lord of Egypt, Pharaoh received Israel's blessing.

When we make Yeshua lord of our life, we also received Israel's blessing.

"I Surrender All"

Joseph took their:

- **A- Money** (v13-15) = their resources
- **B-** Livestock (v16-17) = their future
- **C- Bodies & Land** (v18-19) = Their selves and their security

Then...

D- He reordered their lives (v21)

Genesis 47:25

Matthew 16:23-27
