

יָשַׁע (yasha) = “save”

1st appearance -

Exodus 2:17 The shepherds came and drove them away, but Moses stood up and saved them, and watered their flock.

2nd appearance -

Exodus 14:30 Thus the LORD saved Israel that day from the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore.

3rd appearance -

Numbers 10:9 And when you go to war in your land against the adversary who oppresses you, then you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets, that you may be remembered before the LORD your God, and you shall be saved from your enemies.

4th appearance -

Deuteronomy 20:4 ...for the LORD your God is he who goes with you to fight for you against your enemies, to give you the victory.'

5th appearance -

Deuteronomy 22:27 ...because he met her in the open country, and though the betrothed young woman cried for help there was no one to rescue her.

First three appearances in Psalms:

Psalm 3:7 Arise, O LORD! Save me, O my God! For you strike all my enemies on the cheek; you break the teeth of the wicked.

Psalm 6:4, 10 Turn, O LORD, deliver my life; save me for the sake of your steadfast love.... All my enemies shall be ashamed and greatly troubled; they shall turn back and be put to shame in a moment.

Psalm 7:1 O LORD my God, in you do I take refuge; save me from all my pursuers and deliver me,

σώζω (*sozo*) = “save”

1st Appearance:

Matthew 1:21 She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Yeshua, for he will save his people from their sins."

σωτηρία (*soteria*) = “salvation”

First three appearances:

Luke 1:69-71...76-77 ...and has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David, as he spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets from of old, that we should have salvation from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us;... And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; for you will go before the Lord to prepare his ways, to give knowledge of salvation to his people in the forgiveness of their sins...

THE PROCESS OF SALVATION

1 Thessalonians 5:23

Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah.

SALVATION: PAST

Ephesians 2:5 ...even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ--by grace you have been saved.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

1 Peter 1:23 ...for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, *that is*, through the living and abiding word of God.

SALVATION: PRESENT

James 1:21 Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted **word**, which is able to save your souls.

1 Corinthians 1:18 For the **word** of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

1 Corinthians 15:1-2 Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the **word** I preached to you--unless you believed in vain.

1 Peter 1:8-9 Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

Hebrews 10:39 But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving/saving of the soul.

SALVATION: FUTURE

Romans 8:23 And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are about to inherit salvation?

Romans 8:17 ...and if children, then heirs--heirs of God and fellow heirs with Messiah, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

Mark 10:17 And as he was setting out on his journey, a man ran up and knelt before him and asked him, "Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

Acts 20:32 And now I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Messiah have come, for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God."

SUMMARY

1 Peter 1:3-5 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Yeshua Messiah from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

Philippians 2:12-13 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure
