

# *Matthew's Gospel*

## **Chapter 11**

Matthew 11:1-6

**Psalm 118:26** Blessed is **he who comes** in the name of Adonai!  
We bless you from the house of Adonai.

**Isaiah. 62:10-11** Go through, go through the gates; prepare the way for the people; build up, build up the highway; clear it of stones; lift up a signal over the peoples. Behold, Adonai has proclaimed to the end of the earth: Say to the daughter of Zion, “Behold, **your salvation [Yeshua] comes**; behold, His reward is with Him, and His recompense before Him.”

**Zechariah 9:9-10** Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King **is coming** to you; righteous and having salvation is He, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

**[...2,000 Year Gap...]**

I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim and the war horse from Jerusalem; and the battle bow shall be cut off, and He shall speak peace to the nations; His rule shall be from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth.

**Matthew 11:7-15**

**Isaiah 35:4-6** Say to those who have an anxious heart, “Be strong; fear not! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, with the recompense of God. He will come and save you.” Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf unstopped; then shall the lame man leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute sing for joy...

**Isaiah 61:1-2** The Spirit of the Lord Adonai is upon Me, because Adonai has anointed Me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the year of Adonai’s favor...

## [...2,000 Year Gap...]

... and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn.

### Yeshua's Checklist:

- ✓ The blind are seeing
- ✓ The lame are walking
- ✓ Lepers are becoming pure
- ✓ The deaf are hearing
- ✓ The dead are rising
- ✓ The poor are receiving good news
- to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound

***“And O, the gladness of the man  
who does not stumble because of me!”***

or

***“Blessed is he who is not offended in Me.”***

**Malachi 3:1-4** Behold, I send My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. And the Master whom you seek will suddenly come to His temple; and the messenger of the covenant in whom you delight, behold, he is coming, says Adonai of hosts.

**[...2,000 Year Gap...]**

But who can endure the day of His coming, and who can stand when He appears? For He is like a refiner's fire and like fullers' soap. He will sit as a refiner and purifier of silver, and He will purify the sons of Levi and refine them like gold and silver, and they will bring offerings in righteousness to Adonai. Then the offering of Judah and Jerusalem will be pleasing to Adonai as in the days of old and as in former years.

### **The “Smallest in the Kingdom of Heaven”:**

**Joel 2:28-29** “And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. Even on the male and female servants in those days I will pour out My Spirit.

**Isaiah 40:5** And the glory of Adonai shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of Adonai has spoken.

**Exodus 33:18** Moses said, "Please show me Your glory."

**Jeremiah 31:34** And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know Adonai,' for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares Adonai. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

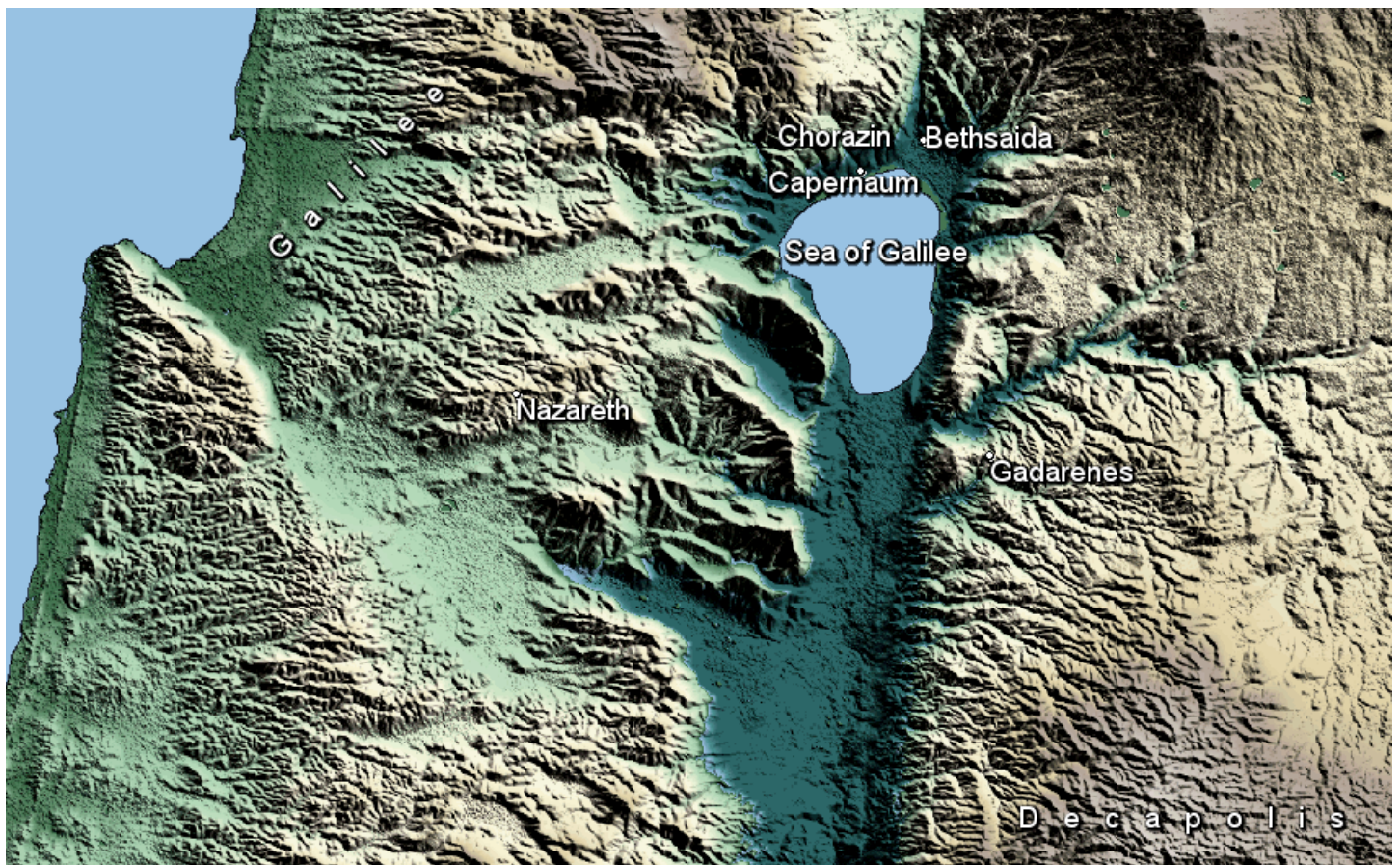
**Micah 2:13** He who opens the breach goes up before them; they break through and pass the gate, going out by it. Their king passes on before them, Adonai at their head.

**Malachi 4:5** Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the great and awesome day of Adonai comes.

**Matthew 11:16-19**

**Deuteronomy 21:18-20** If a man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey the voice of his father or the voice of his mother, and, though they discipline him, will not listen to them, then his father and his mother shall take hold of him and bring him out to the elders of his city at the gate of the place where he lives, and they shall say to the elders of his city, "This our son is stubborn and rebellious; he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton and a drunkard." ...

**21:21-23** ...Then all the men of the city shall stone him to death with stones. So you shall purge the evil from your midst, and all Israel shall hear, and fear. And if a man has committed a crime punishable by death and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree, his body shall not remain all night on the tree, but you shall bury him the same day, for a hanged man is cursed by God. You shall not defile your land that Adonai your God is giving you for an inheritance.



**Hebrews 6:4-6** For it is impossible, in the case of those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have shared in the Holy Spirit, and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come, and then have fallen away, to restore them again to repentance, since they are crucifying once again the Son of God to their own harm and holding Him up to contempt.

**Jeremiah 6:16** Thus says Adonai: “Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls. But they said, ‘We will not walk in it.’”

**1 John 5:2-3** By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey His commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.
