Chapter 26b



Acts 1:13

And when they had entered, they went up to the upper room, where they were staying, Peter and John and James and Andrew...

1 Corinthians 10:16


Is not the cup of blessing which we bless a sharing in the blood of Messiah? ...

Exodus 24:7-8

And they said, “All that Adonai has spoken we will do, and we will hear.” And Moses took the blood and threw it on the people and said, “Behold **the blood of the covenant** that Adonai has made with you in accordance with all these words.”

Jeremiah 31:31-33
