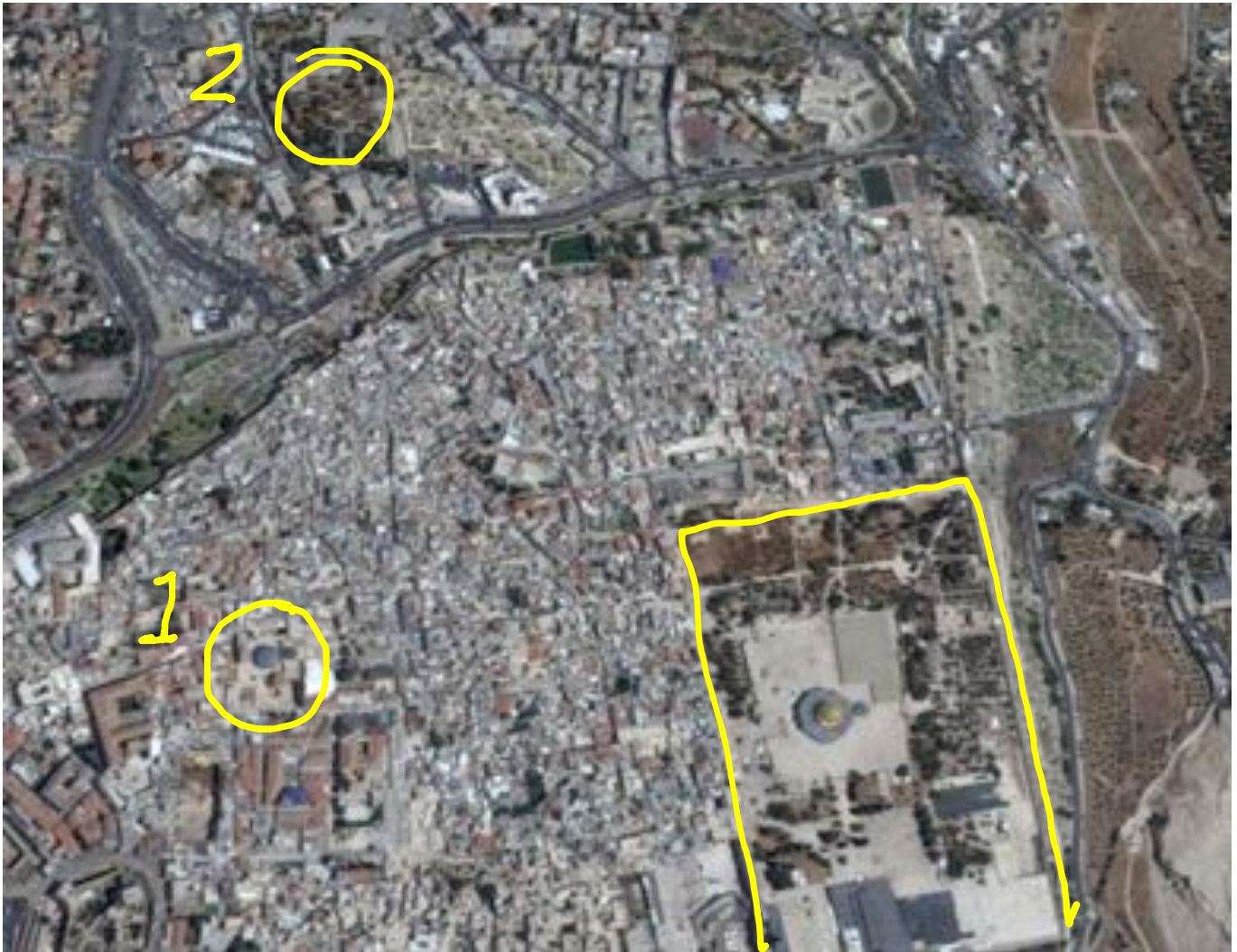
Golgotha

Church of the Holy Sepulcher





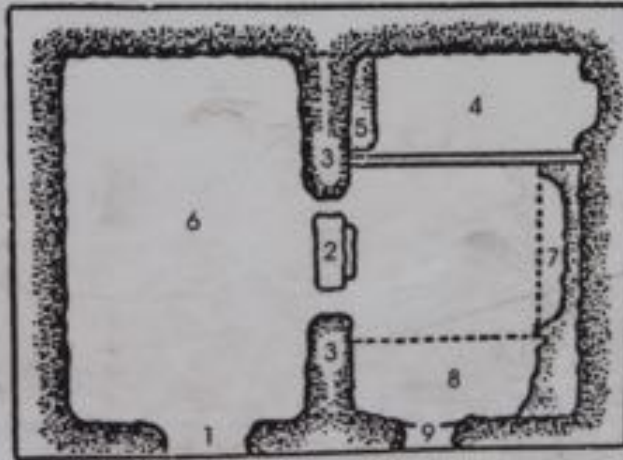


Stone of preparation for burial



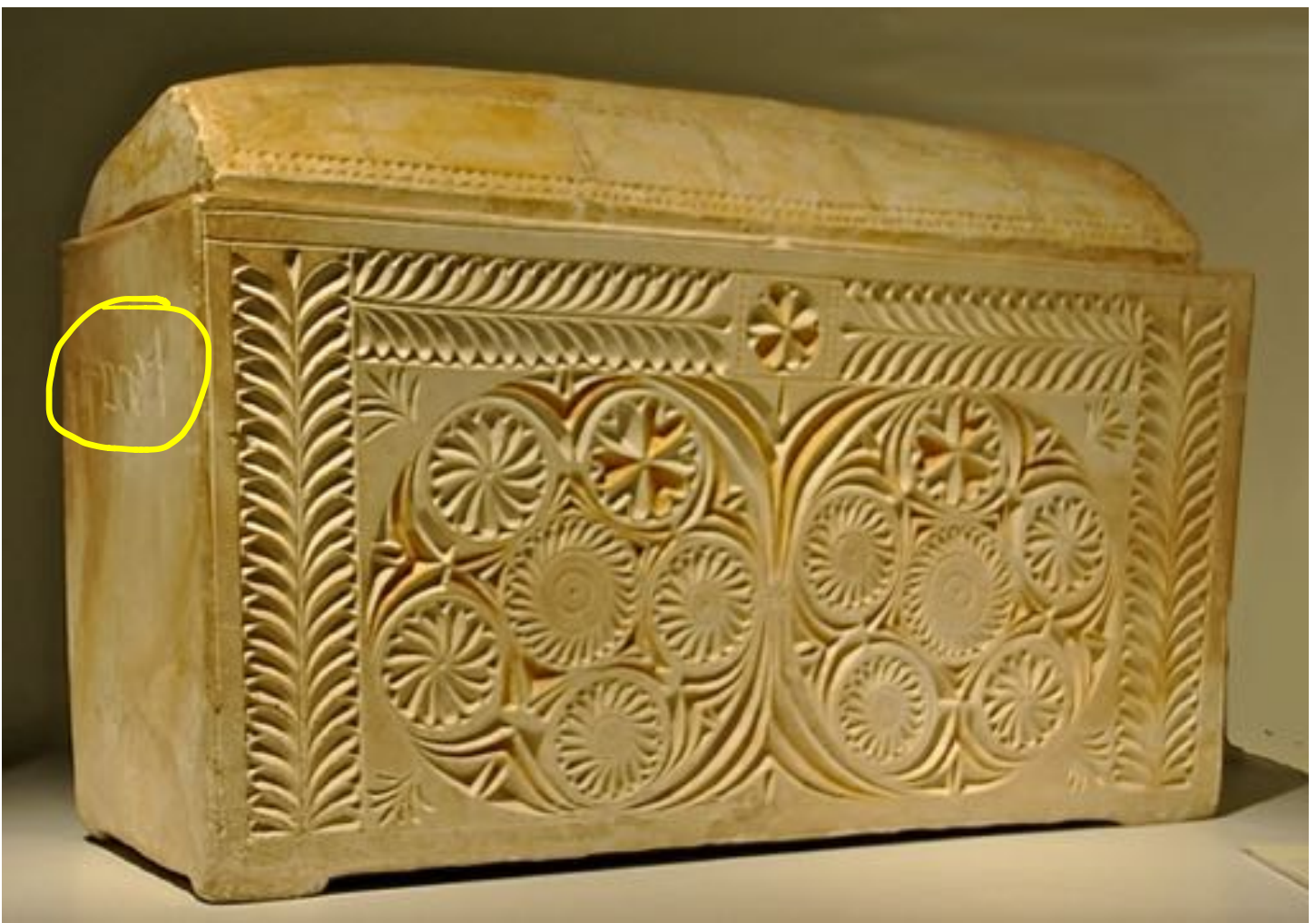


PLAN of the TOMB



- 1 Entrance to outer room, hewn in rock
- 2 Low threshold to graves
- 3 Short low rock walls between the rooms
- 4 Finished loculus (burial place)
- 5 Pillow cut in rock
- 6 Weeping chamber
- 7 Rough ledge
- 8 Unfinished loculus
- 9 Small window

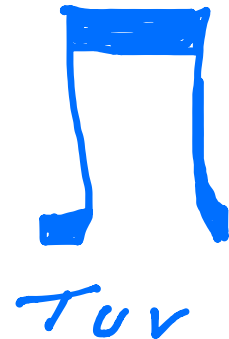
