
Chapter 5b

Q: Why did Yeshua begin His teaching with the "Beatitudes"?

A: Like the Torah, Yeshua's teaching forms a circle.

Deuteronomy 34:12/Genesis 1:1

... and for [the sake of] all the mighty power and all the great deeds of awe that Moses did in the sight of all Israel, in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.



Matthew 12:34

"... For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart."

Deuteronomy 6:6

And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.

Matthew 4:4

But He answered, "It is written, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."

Proverbs 4:4

He taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; keep my commandments, and live."

Q: So, what are the Beatitudes all about?

A: They describe the characteristics of the citizens of Heaven.
