"Do not judge by appearances, but judge with right judgment."





Exodus 29:37

... Whatever touches the altar shall become holy.

Exodus 22:31

You shall be **holy** people to me. Therefore you shall not eat any flesh that is torn by beasts in the field; you shall throw it to the **dogs**.





Which one is holy? What makes it so?

Q: Who is a "dog"?

A: One who does not recognize God's ownership

Leviticus 10:10

You are to distinguish between the holy and the common, and between the unclean and the clean...

1 Corinthians 11:27-32

Therefore, whoever eats the Master's bread or drinks the Master's cup in an unworthy manner will be guilty of desecrating the body and blood of the Master! So let a person examine himself first, and then he may eat of the bread and drink from the cup; for a person who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment upon himself. This is why many among you are weak and sick, and some have died! If we would examine ourselves, we would not come under judgment. But when we are judged by the Master, we are being disciplined, so that we will not be condemned along with the world.

Proverbs 3:15-18

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine **pearls**, who, on finding one **pearl** of great value, went and sold all that he had and bought it.

Revelation 21:12, 21
