Psalm 6:8

Depart from me, all you **workers of evil...**

Matthew 7:23

Depart from me, you **workers of lawlessness...**



A: Psalm 119:53

Hot indignation seizes me because of the wicked, who forsake Your Torah.

ανομία

(*anomia*) = “lawless”

“**Torah-less**”

Matthew 23:28

So you also outwardly appear righteous to others, but within you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.

Matthew 24:12

And because **lawlessness** will be increased, the love of many will grow cold.

Titus 2:14

Who gave Himself for us to redeem us from all **lawlessness** and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession who are zealous for good works.

2 Peter 3:17

You therefore, beloved, knowing this beforehand, take care that you are not carried away with the error of **lawless** people and lose your own **stability**.

1 John 3:4

Everyone who makes a practice of sinning also practices **lawlessness**; sin is **lawlessness**.
