*(zavat dam)*

**“discharge of blood”**

**Mark 5:25**

... had suffered much under many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was no better but rather grew worse.

קום מזוביך

*(kum mizoveicha)*

**“Arise from your discharge!”**

*(b.Shabbos 110b)*

### Malachi 4:2

But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness shall rise with healing in its **wings**. You shall go out leaping like calves from the stall.

*(canaph)*

**“wing” or “corner”**

## Numbers 15:38-39

Speak to the people of Israel, and tell them to make ***tzitzit*** on the **corners** of their garments throughout their generations, and to put a cord of ***techeilet*** on the ***tzitzit*** of each corner. And it shall be a ***tzitzit*** for you to look at and remember all the commandments of Adonai, to do them, not to follow after your own heart and your own eyes, which you are inclined to go astray.



## Ezekiel 8:3

He put out the form of a hand and took me by a *tzitzit* of my head, and the Spirit lifted me up between earth and heaven and brought me in visions of God to Jerusalem...

## Exodus 24:9-10

Then Moses and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel went up, and they saw the God of Israel. There was under His feet as it were a pavement of **sapphire** stone, like the very heaven for clearness.

## Ezekiel 1:26

And above the expanse over their heads there was the likeness of a throne, in appearance like **sapphire**...

## Psalm 104:2

You cover Yourself with light as with a garment, stretching out the heavens like a curtain.

## Matthew 14:35-36

And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent around to all that region and brought to Him all who were sick and implored Him that they might only touch the **corner** of His garment. And as many as touched it were made well.

## Zechariah 8:23

Thus says Adonai of hosts: “In those days ten men from the nations of every tongue shall take hold of the **corner** of a Jew, saying, ‘Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you.’”

## Mark 5:41

Taking her by the hand He said to her, “**Talyeta kumi**,” which means, “Little girl, [I say to you] arise.”
