


Psalms 67 & 72



Attribution: "A Psalm for Solomon"

Last Verse: "The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended."

Jeremiah 33:15-16

"In those days and at that time I will cause a righteous Branch of David to spring forth; and He shall execute justice and righteousness on the earth. In those days Judah shall be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell in safety; and this is the name by which she shall be called: **Adonai tzidkeinu**." ("Adonai is our righteousness.")

In his days may the righteous one flourish, and abundance of peace till the **moon** is no more.


Psalm 72:17

Isaiah 60:19-20

No longer will you have the **sun** for light by day, Nor for brightness will the **moon** give you light; but you will have Adonai for an everlasting light, and your God for your glory. Your **sun** will set no more, neither will your **moon** wane; for you will have Adonai for an everlasting light, and the days of your mourning will be finished.

Revelation 21:23-25

And the city has no need of the **sun** or of the **moon** to shine upon it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp *is* the Lamb. And the nations shall walk by its light, and the kings of the earth shall bring their glory into it. And in the daytime (for there shall be no night there) its gates shall never be closed;
