THE UNIQUENESS OF THE PARAH ADUMAH

- A chukat ha'Torah "decree of the Torah"
- Only sacrifice that must be female
- Only sacrifice that must be a certain color
- Only sacrifice slaughtered outside the camp
- High priest (Aaron) not involved, deputy priest (Elazar) spectates
- Blood sprinkled toward (not in) the tabernacle
- Sacrifice is not skinned or dismembered
- Cedar wood, hyssop & scarlet thread burned with it
- The participants are made ritually unclean by their involvement...
- ...but the sacrifice's ashes provide purification
- Its ashes are gathered and kept outside the camp and taken to all parts of Israel
- No repetition of this sacrifice is commanded
